Statement from AHCA Concerning VA Hospital Visits in Gainesville and Lake City

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The Florida Agency for Health Care Administration continues its efforts to shine a light on the processes of federal Veterans Affairs hospitals in Florida. The Agency attempted to complete onsite reviews of both campuses of the North Florida/South Georgia Veterans Health System today. First, at the Malcom Randall VA Regional Medical Center, entering at 10:30 am, and exiting at 11:07 am, and at Lake City VA Medical Center, entering at 10:46 am and exiting at 11:05 am.

Secretary Dudek said, “The Agency has yet to receive the documents we are looking to receive. We remain committed to helping Governor Scott provide answers for our veterans and their families.”
