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## May Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against 14 Providers, one Additional Provider Terminated from the Medicaid Program

**Tallahassee, Fla.**—The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to 13 providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of May. The Agency issued four final orders to deny a license renewal application, four to revoke an existing license, four that resulted in the providers surrendering their license, and one change of ownership denial. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program; however, the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.

In addition to the final order actions, the Agency issued an emergency suspension for The Four Seasons ALF Community, Inc., an assisted living facility in Charlotte County, because survey inspections found issues that caused a serious threat to residents.

One additional provider was issued a final order terminating them from participation in the Medicaid program in May. This termination resulted from sanctions imposed for failing to reimburse Agency within the timeframes established by the Agency. This provider also has been reported to the federal government for placement on the federal exclusion list, which prohibits them from participating in Medicaid and Medicare nationwide.
