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February Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against 12 Providers, Five Additional Providers Terminated from the Medicaid Program

Tallahassee, Fla.—The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to 12 providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of February. The Agency issued two final orders to deny a license renewal application, eight to revoke an existing license, and two that resulted in the provider surrendering the license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program; however, the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.

In addition to the final order actions, the Agency issued two emergency orders on two providers because survey inspections found issues that caused a serious threat to residents. The Agency placed a moratorium on admissions for Sunrise Home Care Services, an assisted living facility in Bradford County, and issued a licensure suspension for Yan Yan Healthcare, Inc., an assisted living facility in Brevard County.

Five additional providers were issued a final order terminating them from participation in the Medicaid program in February. These terminations resulted from sanctions imposed for pleading guilty of conspiracy to commit health care fraud, and for failing to reimburse the Agency. These providers also have been reported to the federal government for placement on the federal exclusion list, which prohibits them from participating in Medicaid and Medicare nationwide.
