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November Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against Seven Providers, Eight Additional Providers Terminated or Suspended from the Medicaid Program

Tallahassee, Fla.—The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to six providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of November. The Agency issued four final orders to deny a license renewal application, one to revoke an existing license, and one that resulted in the providers surrendering their license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program; however, the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.

In addition to the final order actions, the Agency issued an emergency suspension for Atakelte Admasu d/b/a Agnes Street Home for the Elderly, an assisted living facility in Duval County, because survey inspections found issues that caused a serious threat to residents.

Three additional providers were issued a final order terminating them from participation in the Medicaid program in November. These terminations resulted from sanctions imposed for failing to reimburse the Agency within the timeframes established by the Agency, and for having a license revoked, suspended or terminated by the licensing agency. These providers also have been reported to the federal government for placement on the federal exclusion list, which prohibits them from participating in Medicaid and Medicare nationwide.

There were also five providers suspended from participation in the Medicaid program prohibiting the providers being paid for claims to the Medicaid program for furnishing, supervising a person who is furnishing, or causing a person to furnish goods or services.
