February Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against Nine Providers

Tallahassee, Fla.— The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to nine providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of February.

There were six final orders to revoke an existing license and three that resulted in the provider surrendering their license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program and the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.
