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Statement from Agency for Health Care Administration Regarding Data Breach at Anthem Insurance

The Agency is aware of the recent data breach at Anthem Insurance, the parent company of Amerigroup, which is one of Florida's Medicaid managed care providers. The scope of this cyber-attack is uncertain at this time as Anthem continues to investigate the extent of the data breach. We take the security of Medicaid recipients' data very seriously and we will stay in communication with Amerigroup to determine the impact to Florida Medicaid members.

Anthem has announced that they are currently in the process of notifying affected individuals by mail within the coming weeks. Anthem has also set up a dedicated website called <u>Anthem Facts</u> and will offer credit monitoring free of charge to those whose information may have been compromised. While credit monitoring is not a protection against medical identity theft, it will help protect against financial fraud. Designed to appear as if they are from Anthem, these scam emails are an effort to capture personal information and include a "click here" link for credit monitoring. These emails are <u>not</u> from Anthem. Please do not click on any links or attachments in the email or reply to the email.
