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June Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against Ten Providers, Two Additional Providers Terminated or Suspended from the Medicaid Program

Tallahassee, Fla. – The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to ten providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of June.

There were five final orders to revoke an existing license, three final orders to deny a license renewal application, and two that resulted in the provider surrendering their license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program and the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.

Another two providers were issued a final order terminating them from participation in the Medicaid program. These terminations resulted from sanctions imposed for failing to reimburse the Agency within the timeframes set and for having a license revoked, suspended or terminated by the licensing agency. These providers have been reported to the federal government for placement on the federal exclusion list, which prohibits them from participating in Medicaid and Medicare nationwide.
