In 2011, the Florida Legislature enacted legislation to move away from the fragmented fee-forservice system in Medicaid to provide medical coverage to low-income individuals and families through managed care, with the understanding that people experience better health outcomes when served through a single, comprehensive, coordinated health care delivery system.

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Moreover, the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) recently released a report** showing that in 2014 Florida Medicaid health plans met or exceeded national Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set averages in 65 percent of the categories.

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In fact, AHCA's secretary used the data to assert that the poor, elderly and disabled have never had access to better health care in Florida.

There is clearly a misunderstanding of what is actually occurring in Florida's Medicaid system as evidenced by recent editorials that missed the mark as a result of faulty analysis. The simple fact is, the cost per Floridian receiving health coverage from Medicaid under managed care is lower than under the former fee-for-service program.

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Gov. Rick Scott and the Florida Legislature deserve credit for creating a system that effectively manages health care costs to the state, while providing some of Florida's most vulnerable citizens access to high quality comprehensive health care services.
