




# Medicaid Program Updates


### Management Staffing Changes





#### Medicaid Enrollment

- Total enrollment as of November 11<sup>th</sup>: 5.54 million recipients.
- The 3 month increase in enrollment is 105,274 or an increase of 1.9%.
- The largest portion for the enrollment increase has been children and families (TANF) with an increase of 90,013 recipients.





#### Public Health Emergency (PHE) Extension

- In October, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) extended the public health emergency until January 11.
- HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra has promised to give stakeholders 60 days notice before lifting the emergency declaration.
- HHS did not provide a 60-day notice in time to lift the declaration on January 11. Based on this, the general thought is that the PHE will once again be renewed, effective January 11, 2023, and run for 90 days.



#### **HCBS Funding Opportunity**

- The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) went into effect April 1, 2021.
- Section 9817 of this Act authorized an increased Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) to support Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS).
- There are four one-time funding opportunities currently available:
  - Provider Stipend Payments
  - Provider Retention Payments
  - Delayed Egress
  - 1099 Provider Retention Payments


