





IV&V ASSESSMENT: FX PROGRAM

- IV&V would have rated the FX Program as GREEN since the FX Program is being managed according to FX Standards. However, out of 4 active Modules, 2 are YELLOW, 1 is RED, and 1 is GREEN. IV&V rated the overall FX Program at YELLOW.
- The demand on Agency staff resources continues to increase as additional responsibilities are transitioned to the Agency and new module vendors are onboarded. This demand is increasing the risk of Agency resources becoming constrained. The Agency resource constraints must be resolved, or we recommend to re-plan the module work so the program can have the best chance at success.
- Overall success in multi-vendor programs like FX is predicated on timely integration of each vendor's solutions and schedules. IV&V notes that the risk of project delays is increasing as new vendors are onboarded, and dependencies between vendors increase.
- FX Leadership continues to face challenges typically associated with complex system
 modernization efforts. The added complexity of the FX Program's multi-vendor approach and
 growing number vendors is resulting in a need for increased management of vendors and
 program oversight.





IV&V ASSESSMENT: EDW

- The EDWI Project Schedule for the stabilization period defined by the contract amendment has been approved and baselined with Go-Live targeted for March 2024.
- Stabilization Release 1 System Integration Testing was completed on August 25, 2023, although the Agency has yet to approve the results.
- User Acceptance Testing began on September 5, 2023.
- The DSS Transition Assessment Report has remained in the review/remediation cycle since May 2023 due to the Agency not receiving the detail necessary for approval.
 - Contained a list of items with no analysis, yet this is an Assessment report.
 - The roadmap/next steps was more of an outline than a plan.







IV&V ASSESSMENT - UOC

- The UOCI Vendor's proposed solution cannot integrate with the FX single-sign-on (SSO) solution.
- There are many late tasks in the UOCI project schedule, and while the vendor acknowledges that future tasks are being worked on, the project schedule is no longer a true representation of the work being performed.
- The UOCI Vendor's deliverables and work products continue to have quality issues such as missing content, lack of details, not aligning to Agency-approved Deliverable Expectation Documents (DEDs), and/or a lack of adherence to FX Standards.
- The OCM activities have been delayed because of the quality concerns identified in the OCM DEDs thus impacts the overall progress of the project.







IV&V ASSESSMENT - Core

- Core project decisions do not adhere to the FX Standard that requires inclusion of all the discussion points, all required fields populated, and appropriate reviews.
- The FX Core Project Schedule (v005) remains in comment remediation with ongoing working sessions to address reviewer comments.
- The Core Vendor has actively participated in FX interface discussions and collaborated with other module vendors.
- The Core Vendor addressed and closed the two open project issues during this reporting period.







IV&V ASSESSMENT - PSM

- The overall PSM Procurement schedule was 96% complete as of the end of this reporting period with tasks for contract finalization and closeout remaining.
- The PSM Vendor's contract for the design, development and implementation of a provider solution was approved by CMS on August 23, 2023, during this reporting period.
- The planned execution of the PSM DDI project is planned for early October 2023, pending contract approval and finalization.







Assessment Scope



The assessment must include, but not be limited to:

- (1) verification of current project status and trajectory and the project's progress against the current roadmap;
- (2) validation of project planning for in-flight and future modules;
- (3) identification of risks to project and organizational scope, schedule, budget, and quality;
- (4) identification of risks to achieving project, stakeholder, and organizational goals and objectives;
- (5) identification of opportunities for improved adherence to project, state, and federal requirements and improved alignment to project planning;
- (6) assessment of alignment and adherence to the State Medicaid Director Letter released by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services in April 2022;
- (7) a review of the stated versus actual priorities of the project;
- (8) an assessment of the alignment of project priorities against agency, state, and federal priorities; and
- (9) an assessment of planned enterprise interoperability and data sharing and identification of additional opportunities for additional enterprise interoperability and data sharing.

The assessment shall be provided to the chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee, the chair of the House of Representatives Appropriations Committee, the Executive Office of the Governor's Office of Policy and Budget, and the Agency for Health Care Administration.

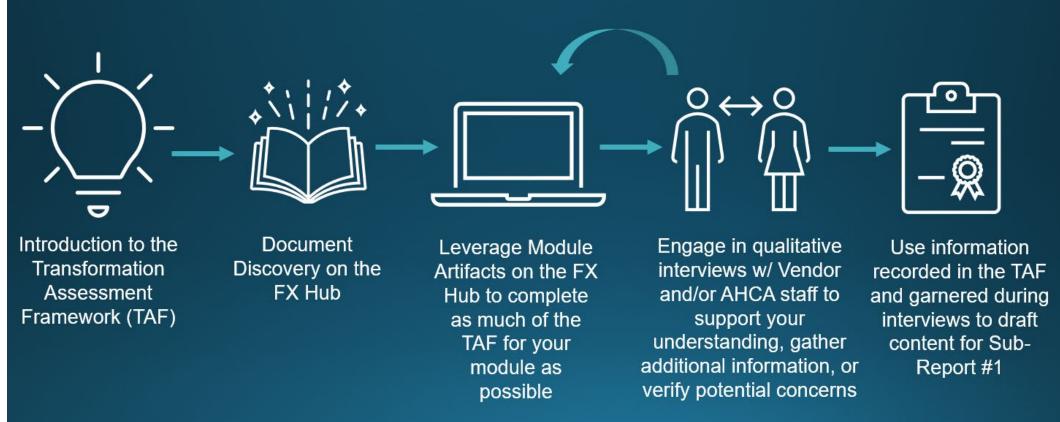





IS/IP O&M PERFORMANCE METRICS – July and August

There are eight (8) performance metrics that are identified as part of MED205.

Level 1 (Critical and High) Incident Tickets

PM-1 S

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which lists the incidents tickets by category and shows the incidents which were completed on time and which ones were not completed within the agreed upon timeframe.



Application and System Availability

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows the amount of total time the ESB system was unavailable and the calculated percent of availability time for the month.

Key Updates

- · Established FXNet and began onboarding FX Vendors.
- Completed Production Jira and Confluence upgrades to latest LTS versions.
- Applied Linux, Windows, Middleware, Database, and Security patches to IS/IP environments.
- Completed software renewals for ForgeRock and SmartBear Ready API Testing.
- Collaborated with the Agency to operationalize a Tableau dashboard for tracking AHCA IT Help Desk ticket status.

Staffing Levels



The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows the number of agreed upon staff and the number of vacant positions. Staffing level is calculated by dividing the total active staff by the number of agreed upon staff for the month.



Production Reports

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows the total number of production reports scheduled and the number of reports delivered or available as scheduled. This metric is calculated by dividing the number of reports delivered or accessible on time each month by the total number reports scheduled for the month.



Performance Report

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Report which shows the agreed to performance metrics. The Financial Consequences for failure to provide the report timely or in a manner acceptable to the Agency shall be \$500.00 a day for each business day the report is not received or acceptable.

Enterprise Service Bus End-to-End Response Time



The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows the number of ESB transactions, the average response time per day and the number of ESB transactions each month which are more than 1.000 second.



Enterprise Service Bus Transaction Errors

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows the number of ESB transactions and the number of ESB transactions errors each calendar day, with a calculation for each calendar day to show the daily error rate.



Master Data Management Performance

The Vendor shall submit a Monthly Performance Standards Report Card which shows MDM transactions, the average transaction time each calendar day and the number of MDM linkage updates each month greater than two (2.000) minutes and number of daily linkage average retrieval times greater than 0.400 seconds.
