Dear ESRD Provider:

We want to thank all dialysis facilities throughout Florida for the work you do to ensure the safety and wellbeing of your patients throughout the state. We are aware Hurricane Milton necessitated the temporary closure of dialysis facilities throughout the state. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) requirements included in the State Operations Manual (Section 2280) indicate for temporary closures of more than one day of operations (including disasters) dialysis facilities are required to submit water testing results performed after re-starting the water system to the state survey agency (AHCA). This documentation must include chemical analysis, cultures, and endotoxin levels.

To maintain ongoing openings of facilities in a timely manner, we are asking that all facilities that closed for over 24 hours due to Hurricane Milton, submit an attestation these water tests were completed and acceptable parameters were met prior to initiating patient treatments. Please send test results with the attestation. The information should be emailed to the local AHCA field office for the facility's location (see below) within five business days of re-opening or five business days of receipt of this notice (for facilities that have already re-opened).
