## **Newly Covered Services**

- In the new SMMC contracts, health plans are responsible for covering services that were previously fee-for-service.
- These newly covered services include:
  - -Early Intervention Services (EIS)/ Early Steps
  - -Medical Foster Care
  - Targeted Case Management (TCM)
  - -Nursing Facility Services for Managed Medical Assistance



## **Health Plan Responsibilities**

- To ensure a smooth transition of these services to the health plans, the Agency built in specific plan contractual requirements related to:
  - Screening Services
  - Multidisciplinary Team Meetings
  - Service Delivery Model
  - Service Authorization
  - Coordination of Care
  - Provider Network
  - Continuity of Care
  - Provider Reimbursement
